## 2018 Do Not Spray Request Form

### Mosquito Management Program

Franklin County Public Health (FCPH) maintains a Do Not Spray registry of residents who do not want to have their property treated for adult mosquitoes through the use of truck-mounted spraying on public roadways and alleys. FCPH will make a good faith effort to shut off truck-mounted spraying equipment within approximately 150 feet of a registered property. This registry will be rendered inactive if the Health Commissioner declares a public health emergency where treatment is indicated. In the event of a public health emergency, FCPH will attempt to contact members of the registry prior to treatment of their property. We post maps of our scheduled spray areas on our website at <https://mosquito.myfcph.org/>.

Please complete the fields below. Sign and date the form, and mail or fax to Franklin County Public Health at the address/fax number listed at the bottom of this form. The request will take effect within five (5) business days of our receipt of this information. This request is only good for one (1) calendar year and a new request needs to be submitted each year that you wish to be exempt. This request for exemption from adult mosquito control is considered public information and we are required to provide this information to a requesting party.
